Their proposed research would focus on the character and dynamics of teen and young adult violent relationships and would build on the Toledo Adolescent Relationships Study (TARS).

NSFG Public Use Data

The 2006-2008 **National Survey of Family Growth** provides data for men and women age 15-44 about marriage, divorce, pregnancy, infertility, contraception use, and men's and women's health. NSFG data is now collected in a continuous format, allowing for data to cover longer periods of time and to be released in a more timely manner.
