### **FRC Internal Grant Programs – Applications due November 4**

The Faculty Research Committee (FRC) at BGSU is offering awards of up to \$10,000 to support research resulting in the submission of external grant applications:

- Grants to support projects leading to major external grant proposals requesting over \$100,000 in total costs per year (FRC award amounts up to \$10,000)
- Grants for projects leading to small external proposals seeking less than \$100,000 in total costs (FRC award amounts up to \$1,500)

Smaller awards are also available to cover travel (up to \$750) and research mini-grants (up to \$500).
