The Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) is a publication of unemployment statistics in an accessible format. Using the Current Population Survey and state administrative sources, it provides an accurate representation of unemployment trends in a smaller area such as the state, metropolitan area, or county. Because it includes FIPS county codes it can easily be linked with other datasets that provide county statistics on poverty, health insurance, and migration.
