Free May Webinar: Schedules of Work and Child Care in the National Survey of Early Care and Education

This webinar will describe the types of information available about parental work schedules in the NSECE and will outline ways in which parental work data can be linked to children's non-parental care usage. The webinar will also be of interest to researchers interested in either the parental work schedule data or the data on children's schedules in non-parental care, even without linking the two. The 60-minute webinar, will take place on May 24 from 2-3pm. They will discuss nationally-representative data from more than 11,000 households in the 2012 NSECE Household Survey reporting parental time in work-related activities and their children's time in non-parental care.
