Introducing IPUMS Medical Expenditure Panel Survey (MEPS)

IPUMS has announced the release of IPUMS MEPS, an ongoing panel survey with information on health status, medical conditions, healthcare utilization, and healthcare expenditures for the U.S. civilian, non-institutionalized population. It began in 1996 and is collected by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality. The initial, beta release of IPUMS MEPS includes over 1,000 annual summary variables from the 1996-2014 MEPS Full Year Consolidated files. Visit meps.ipums.org for more information.
