Census Bureau Releases Wave 2 of the 2014 SIPP Panel

The U.S. Census Bureau has released the initial version of public data from the reengineered Survey of Income and Program Participation (SIPP). This dataset contains variables from Wave 2 of the 2014 SIPP panel. The SIPP is the Census Bureau’s premier survey for measuring the dynamics of income, employment, health insurance, and participation in government transfer programs. The survey provides detailed, monthly information about the family, social, and economic contexts of individuals and households. SIPP is a longitudinal survey, following the same set of respondents over a four-year period, allowing researchers to understand how these contexts change over time.
