Funding Opportunity from the William T. Grant Foundation

- **Focus Areas:** (1) reducing inequality and (2) the use of research evidence, are focused on young people between ages 5 and 25
- **Award amount:** \$100,000 to \$1,000,000 for two to four years of support
- **Letters of Inquiry:** Three per year: January, May, and August. The next deadline for LOIs is **August 1, 2019**.
