Grant Opportunity: Horowitz Foundation

The Horowitz Foundation for Social Policy is now accepting applications for 2019 grants. They plan to offer **25 grants** for the most outstanding research in social policy by PhD candidates. CURS Grants – New Submission Deadlines

For the 2019/20 academic year, the Center for Undergraduate Research and Scholarship (CURS) will shift to a new cycle for grant applications, so they will be able to award grants for each semester prior to the start of a given semester. This will allow students and their faculty mentors more time to complete their projects during the semester. The submission deadline for the CURS fall 2019 grant round will be **Monday the 5th of August** at 5pm.

Faculty Research Development Award – Submission deadline August 5th

The submission deadline for the CFDR FDA has been extended to August 5, 2019. The CFDR is pleased to award one to three seed grants with budgets ranging from \$7,500-10,000.
