Research Enhancement Award (R15)

- Supports small-scale research projects at educational institutions that provide baccalaureate or advanced degrees for a significant number of the Nation's research scientists but that have not been major recipients of NIH support.
- **BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY** qualifies



Qualify Institution and Investigator

- NIH totaling no more than \$6 million per year (in both direct and F&A/indirect costs) in 4 of the last 7 fiscal years.
- PI may not be the PI of an active NIH research grant at the time of a R15 award.
 - Key Personnel for an active NIH grant held by another PD/PI.

Why ? Funding Lines

R01 ?? 5 years

R21 \$275,000 2 years (no renewal)

R03 \$100,000 2 years (no renewal)

R15

- Three Years
- \$300,000/ year
- Renewal option
- 12 pages (single spaced)

- The application should propose a research team, including undergraduate and/or graduate students, that is appropriate to accomplish the specific aims and to make an important scientific contribution.
