Research Enhancement Award (RI5)

- Supports small-scale research projects at educational institutions that provide baccalaureate or advanced degrees for a significant number of the Nation's research scientists but that have not been major recipients of NIH support.
- BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY qualifies





Qualify Institution and Investigator

- •NIH totaling no more than \$6 million per year (in both direct and F&A/indirect costs) in 4 of the last 7 fiscal years.
- PI may not be the PI of an active NIH research grant at the time of a RI5 award.
 - Key Personnel for an active NIH grant held by another PD/PI.
