Complete application files should include:

- 1) letter outlining qualifications relevant to this position;
- 2) a CV which includes a list of graduate courses taken and brief descriptions of courses taught;
- 3) two current original letters of reference;
- 4) official transcripts indicating highest degree earned and sent directly from degree-granting institution to the BGSU Department of English.

Final candidates are required to authorize and pass a background check prior to an offer of employment. Unless they request otherwise, qualified applicants will also be considered for future part-time employment opportunities that may arise.
