

Assistant Teaching Professor

Two faculty positions (non-tenure track) with rank of Assistant Teaching Professor, Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Bowling Green State University. Full-time, academic year, one-year nonrenewable contract. Competitive salary with full benefits. Duties include: Teach courses in the Math Emporium, the quantitative reasoning course, or other mathematics and statistics courses, depending on qualifications and department need; provide service to the department, college, and university. Minimum qualifications: Master's degree in mathematics, statistics, or in a closely related field (e.g., mathematics education) conferred at the time of application; experience teaching a college algebra or quantitative reasoning course as a TA or instructor of record. Preferred qualifications: Experience teaching in a Mathematics Emporium; experience teaching an elementary statistics course as an instructor of record; experience teaching an online course. Starting date: August 10, 2022.

- (3) statement describing both teaching and professional development
- (4) a statement of commitment to diversity in higher education that addresses how you have incorporated equity, diversity, and/or inclusion into your current or a previous position

- (6) copy of transcript showing the highest degree earned

Finalist will be required to submit official transcripts and to authorize and pass a background check prior to an offer of employment being made.
