VIII. Research Interests

In my research, writing, and advocacy about close relationships and relational communication, I incorporate theory and research from a variety of interpersonal, sexuality, health, feminist, and culture literatures to interrogate sexualities, identities, and relational expectations and forms. I focus on the role of culture, discourse, and identities and how these influence relational processes and understandings. I engage with critical qualitative approaches and community-based research projects to examine how individuals negotiate stigmatized and marginalized identities in their relationships and communities and the tensions that must be negotiated.

I have expertise in qualitative and critical qualitative methodologies, especially poetic inquiry.

I am interested in critical qualitative approaches to the study of family and interpersonal communication. Recent projects include interrogations into white motherhood, the use of ABR as inclusive pedagogical practice, teacher characteristics and behaviors that create welcoming and inclusive classrooms, and the negotiation of political differences in families.
