- The top three applicants will be selected on the following criteria and will be interviewed by the scholarship committee:
 - Academic strength.
 - Work history.
 - Individuals ability to 'sell' why they are the best candidate.
 - Any other criteria the committee deems relevant.
- Award and alternates will be announced on or before 8/1/2019.

CRITERIA FOR MAINTENANCE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

In order to for a successful applicant to retain the scholarship year to year they must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the scholarship committee the following on an annual basis:

1. Applicant is in fact enrolled at Bowling Green State University in the approved courses of study.
2. Applicant maintains a 3.0 Cumulative GPA.
3. Applicant is taking course work in proper sequence, quantity and quality to ensure on time graduation.
4. Applicant must demonstrate they work in a paying position 1,000 hours per year.
5. Applicant's general conduct is in good standing inside and outside the classroom.

*The committee will make individual adjustments to scholarship funding based on an Applicant participating in a CO-OP program or military service.

** Evaluation of any and all criteria is solely at the discretion of the scholarship committee.
