Training is fully funded through the State of Ohio's Individual Microcredential Assistance Program (IMAP).

## ELIGIBILITY

- Must be an Ohio resident
- High school juniors or seniors may qualify
- Incarcerated individuals eligible within 12 months of release
- Not eligible: BGSU or State of Ohio employees

- Earn a digital badge that highlights your achievement throughout your career
- Learn in flexible online format within published 4-week window

## HOW TO ENROLL

**Request enrollment.** Use the QR code to access more information about the trainings and submit your enrollment request form.

**Complete a brief phone interview.** A BGSU trainer may request a brief interview to confirm eligibility and fit. You may also request an interview.

**Receive acceptance confirmation.** You'll receive an email with your official acceptance and instructions to get started.

**Begin training.** Access your training materials and begin learning on the scheduled start date.
