DIVISION 01—GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

FORMAT

1. Technical specifications content and numbering system shall be based on the 2004 version of CSI MasterFormat.

BASIS OF DESIGN

- BGSU Design standards shall not replace fully developed, project and market specific technical specification. Architect/Engineer (A/E) shall utilize the Standards as a minimum standard to guide the design and execution in the field. Exceptions to these standards are allowed provided they are approved by Design & Construction.
- 2. In instances where fewer than 3 manufacturers are indicated, the A/E shall insert "or approved substitute" in the Products section of the technical specifications.
- 3. All submitted substitute products shall be brought to the attention of Design & Construction, prior to approval.

01 41 00—REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All construction requiring public utility taps, curb cuts, site work adjacent to City of Bowling Green rights of way and easements shall be provided to Bowling Green Department of Public Works (419-354-6227) for their review at each phase of design.
- 2. No permit is required with the City of Bowling Green.

01 41 13—REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS-CODES

 Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Industrial Compliance and Labor, Bureau of Building Code Compliance has sole jurisdictional authority over permitting for projects covered by the Ohio Building Code.

01 56 26—TEMPORARY FENCING

- 1. Construction sites shall be protected by an 8' chainlink fence. Gate location shall be decided upon in consultation with Project Manager.
- 2. Mechanically attached platforms are permissible, if existing conditions do not allow driven posts.
