Course Name: Practicum in individual and small group instruction

Learning Outcomes:

- Provide students with an opportunity to tutor one child or a small group of children throughout the semester.
- Provide students with experience in planning, implementing, and evaluating
- Instructional materials and activities.
- Provide students with a forum to engage in discussions about connecting theories, concepts, and principles in educational psychology to their tutoring experience.
- Provide students with opportunities to develop relevant instructional and professional skills, such as professional responsibility, active listening, and providing effective feedback to others.

Placement Requirements:

- 60 mile radius

Hours Required:

- 14 hours in direct contact with one student or a small group of students
- 6 hours of online discussions and other non-site learning activities

 - Helping out in a classroom
 - Helping out in an before/after school program
