#### Research & Instrument Data Collection

- » Requested college, department, and school course evaluations from A-Deans
- » Received (over 60) evaluation instruments from every college
- Conducted a content analysis of those questions and categorized questions by themes
- Shared questions and themes with faculty at Teaching and Learning Fair to receive feedback

- » Feedback & Assessment
- » Instructor Availability
- Engagement in Learning & Connections
- » Instructor Effectiveness & Environment
- » Instructor Communication
- » Assignments
- » Expectations
- Course Organization & Clarity

### Qualtrics Survey of Faculty

- » Development
  - Used themes and questions identified during content analysis
- » Purpose
  - » Gather feedback from faculty as to which potential questions would be <u>most</u> helpful to their teaching.
  - » Solicit volunteers for Pilot I (Dec 2016)
- » Approximately 10-min Survey
  - » 45 likert-scale questions
