Eligibility

Any Bowling Green State University faculty member, excluding members of the selection committee is eligible.

Procedures

- 1. Any BGSU faculty member may make a nomination for this recognition.
- 2. The nominator should submit a letter of nomination (no more than 500 words); vita for the nominee (maximum of 10 pages), and two (no more than one page each) letters of support.
