Voting on the Closing of the Ogg Science Library as a Charter Violation

Williams said that several persons had raised the issue of conflict of interest because the member of SEC who alleged the violation had also participated in the vote. Hebein said that he searched the minutes for the last time a member of SEC had done so and found that the SEC member participated in the discussion but absented himself from the vote. There was considerable discussion on conflict of interest, the lack of a violation of any written policies, and the role of perception. The consensus was that SEC's finding of a violation should go forward.

As required by *Charter*, the secretary reported that a senator had been sent a warning after the second absence and notification after the third that SEC would declare the seat vacant if an appeal was not submitted. Since no appeal was made, SEC declared the seat vacant and directed the secretary to so inform the senator.
