2. Qualifications/preferred skills

- One year prior experience in the area of strength and conditioning, physical fitness, and weight training.
- Possessing or working towards a SCCC, CSCS, or USAW certification.
- CPR/AED/First Aid certification required.
- Must have and maintain a valid driver's license and comply with the university's vehicle use policy.

3. Position Description (primary and secondary responsibilities)

- Design and implement strength training and conditioning programs for assigned sports.
- Frequently communicate with sport coaches and sports medicine staff.
- Implement training programs based upon sound physiological principles.
- Clean and maintain the weight room and all strength and conditioning equipment.
- Provide a safe and productive environment.
- Assist in training of all other sport teams.
- Any duties directed by the Director of Strength and Conditioning.
- Must have the ability to work in the collegiate setting with collegiate athletes, coaches and other athletic department staff.
- Excellent verbal communication skills.
- Very strong interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of NCAA rules/regulations.
- Creativity.
- Proficient computer skills
