**Position Description:** The Department of Public and Allied Health at Bowling Green State University (BGSU), Bowling Green, Ohio is seeking applicants for two (2) 9-month tenure-track positions at the Assistant Professor or Associate Professor level. With the development of a new Masters in Health Services Administration, the program seeks individuals to join our undergraduate and graduate programs during an exciting time of growth and new opportunities.

**Primary responsibilities:** The selected candidates will play a major and collaborative role in the growth and development of a new Masters in Health Services Administration. In addition to teaching at the graduate level, responsibilities may also include courses in the undergraduate healthcare administration, public health degree programs. Other responsibilities include establishing a record of high quality research and publication, participating on academic committees, advising students, supervising graduate students, and providing professional service through community engagement and professional societies.

**Qualifications:** Earned doctorate in Healthcare Administration, Business, Public Health, or related field. ABD candidates will be considered but must complete the degree prior to the start of employment. The preferred candidates will have a background in healthcare administration with expertise in areas such as health information systems, healthcare operations and supply chain management, healthcare finance, health economics, data analytics, health services management, human resources or healthcare law and ethics. Online teaching experience is preferred. Candidates applying for the Associate Professor rank are expected to have a proven record of scholarship as evidenced by peer reviewed publications/grants.

**Salary:** Competitive and commensurate with peer institution levels for rank and position and in keeping with candidate's experience and credentials.

Applicants should submit a letter of application and full curriculum vitae summarizing their suitability for the job, a description of their research plan, a statement of teaching experience/philosophy, contact information and contact information for three professional references.
