



Grant Application

Submit a Written Proposal that follows the format below:

- I. Heading: College of Health and Human Services PILLARS Grant Application
 - A. Short Title specific to your grant request
- II. Student's name, address, phone and email address
- III. Current Date
- IV. Dates for which funding is requested, if applicable
- V. Student's Program of Study, expected graduation date, and overall GPA
- VI. Describe in approximately 200 – 400 words the purpose of your proposal for PILLARS funding. Include a statement about how your proposal relates to your academic goals
- VII. Prepare a budget with details of your financial needs and/or overall costs associated with your proposal
 - A. If asking for funds to travel to a conference or workshop, please include a copy of your survey or other information that is demonstrative of your research
 - B. If asking for funds to help support research activities, please include a copy of your survey or other information that is demonstrative of your research
 - C. If asking for funds to present at a conference, provide a copy of your acceptance letter/email confirming you will be a presenter
- VIII. The amount requested for your proposal and an indication of whether a partially-funded award is acceptable
- IX. Include a letter of support from a faculty advisor or department chairperson
- X. Only one person may apply per application
- XI. Multiple applications from the same individual will not be accepted in the same academic year

NOTE: Funds will not be disbursed to the student until the project has been completed and a required project summary report, including receipts, is submitted to the PILLARS Committee. (Project Summary and receipts must be submitted within 30 days following the funded event.)

Pillars application deadlines are September 30th and January 30th

Applications will be reviewed during Fall and Spring semesters only; applications will not be accepted during Summer terms.
