Furthermore, please identify and explain an idea for research that could have a significant impact on the issue/problem.
Note that the content and style of your essay will be important to the success of your scholarship application. Assume that your reader is knowledgeable in mathematics, science, and engineering and will have the expertise to read, review, and understand the complexities of your field of specialty, while also being understandable to a general science audience. Also, if your essay makes reference to research in which you are or were involved, then please indicate if you are or were the sole researcher, or if you collaborated with another individual. The research statement can be attached as a separate word doc.
