1. Doctorate (earned Ph.D.) in Historical Musicology.
2. Demonstrated research productivity through one or more published or in press journal articles or book chapters related to music of the 20th-21st centuries in peer-reviewed music outlets.
3. Minimum of one year experience teaching music history courses at the college level.

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Secondary expertise in critical theory, aesthetics, interdisciplinary studies, cultural studies, demonstrated through cognate area or research activity (one or more conference presentations or publications on a relevant topic) is desirable.
