Instructor of Trombone, Full-time, Nontenure track, 1 year nonrenewable

Primary Responsibilities

Responsibilities will include teaching undergraduate and graduate applied trombone, conducting the Trombone Choir, coaching chamber music, undergraduate and graduate recruiting, advising, and contributing to the artistic and intellectual life of the College and University. Other duties may be assigned depending upon the needs of the Department of Music Performance Studies and the College of Musical Arts. Salary is dependent upon the candidate's experience and credentials.

- 1. Earned Doctorate or Master's degree with a minimum of 3 years professional performing experience.
- 2. Teaching experience at the collegiate level preferred.
- 3. Notable experience in all facets of classical trombone performance (i.e. symphonic, opera, ballet, brass quintet, chamber music and solo performance).
