## ABOUT THE ARTIST IOANA GALU

Ioana Galu, a native of Romania, has enjoyed a national and international career in both Europe and the United States. She earned her bachelor's and master's degrees in violin performance from the Gheorghe Dima Music Academy in Cluj, Romania, later joining the faculty as an assistant professor of violin and chamber music. After coming to the United States, she earned a second master's degree in violin performance from Bowling Green State University and continued her studies at the University of Cincinnati's College Conservatory of Music, where she received an Artist Diploma. In 2012, Galu graduated with a doctorate in Contemporary Music from Bowling Green State University. Her most important teachers were Victoria Nicolae, Alexandru Gavrilovici, Vasile Beluska, Yim Won Bin and Penny Thompson Kruse. Currently, Dr. Galu is violinist of the Rawlins Piano Trio and Assistant Professor of Violin at the University of South Dakota.
