BGSU COLLEGE OF MUSICAL ARTS 2023 AUDITION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

Ensemble Requirements:

- All undergraduate music majors are required to audition and enroll in a major ensemble each semester they are enrolled for applied lessons.
 Ensemble choices should be appropriate to the student's major and principal instrument.
- Most ensembles require a placement audition.
- Graduate music students choose the ensembles in which they wish to perform depending on their preference and in consultation with their studio teacher and ensemble directors.

Audition Schedules and Procedures

Choral Ensembles:

MIXED CHORUSES

A CAPPELLA CHOIR, COLLEGIATE CHORALE, UNIVERSITY CHORAL SOCIETY

All university students are invited to audition for the BGSU mixed choruses. Auditionees are asked to bring a prepared piece and will be asked to sight sing.

A CAPPELLA CHOIR (MWF 1:30-2:20)

The A Cappella Choir is a select ensemble of approximately forty singers. Dr. Munson is director of the A Cappella Choir.

COLLEGIATE CHORALE (MW at 2:30-3:20 and TR at 2:30-3:45)

The Collegiate Chorale is a highly select ensemble of approximately thirty singers. Dr. Schnipke is director of the Collegiate Chorale.

UNIVERSITY CHORAL SOCIETY (Tuesday evenings 7:30-9:30)

The UCS is a symphonic chorus that performs major works with orchestra and consists of students, university faculty, university staff, and community singers.

Dr. Munson is director of the University Choral Society.

VOLARÉ (MWF at 12:30 – 1:20)

Volaré (formerly University Women's Chorus) is a large ensemble consisting of students with a variety of majors. - · Please arrive by 6pm and stay until auditions are over.

<u>Lab Band Instruments</u> (saxophones, trumpets, trombones): Tuesday, August 22, from 1:00-3:30 pm, Choral Room (Room 1040)

- Read a lab band part, soloing optional but encouraged.
- Saxophones 1:00-1:50, trumpets 1:50-2:40, trombones 2:40-3:30.
- · Auditions heard in order of arrival.

<u>Chamber Jazz Ensemble Horns</u> (all non-rhythm section instruments): Tuesday, August 22, from 6:00-7:30 pm, Room 2019b

Prepare an American songbook tune or a jazz standard. Play melody and solo.

Preparing your Orchestra Audition Excerpts:

Part I Everyone must bring a prepared solo to the audition.

You will play a passage from it as requested by the faculty present.

Part II Orchestra Excerpts

- 1. Download and print out the excerpts or use on your device.
- 2. Prepare all excerpts posted for your instrument. The audition committee will select which ones you perform at the audition.
- 3. Listen to a recording while following the excerpts to learn tempo and musical style.
- 4. Contact your teacher if you have any questions about the excerpts.

-ALL HORN PLAYERS must prepare the Exposition of Mozart's Horn Concerto No. 2, K. 417 in E-flat as their solo.
