

Make a One Rules

You need:

deck of forty cards, ten each of 1s, 2s, 4s, and 8s (for Version 1)

deck of forty cards, ten each of 1s, 3s, 6s, and 12s (for Version 2)

Make a One worksheet

a partner and another pair to play with

Rules for Version 1

1. One person mixes the Version 1 deck of cards and leaves them facedown.
2. Each pair takes ten cards.
3. Try to use as many of your cards as you can to make fractions that add to one. Write the fractions on your worksheet and fill in your score. You score one point for each box you fill in when making your fractions.
4. When everyone has completed the round, return to Step 1 and continue.
5. Play five rounds and figure your total score. The team with the highest score wins.

Rules for Version 2

Play the same way as you do for Version 1, but use the Version 2 deck of cards.

Rules for Version 3

Play the same way as you do for Versions 1 and 2, but shuffle both decks of cards together.
