



STEM in the Park FAQ's

What is STEM in the Park? How does it work? STEM in the Park features over 100 hands-on activities and interactive displays to engage children of all ages in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. Visitors are welcome to visit as many activity tables as they would like in any order they choose. NEW THIS YEAR: The STEM Stage showcasing larger scale, eye-popping science demos and The STEAM Stage highlighting the 'Arts' with various musical groups performing.

Do I have to pre-register or can I just show up? Either. You can pre-register online at www.STEMinthepark.org, this will get you through the doors faster. But you are also welcome to register on-site before entering.

How much does it cost? What do I have to pay for? This is a FREE family event including lunch and drinks, there is absolutely no money needed!

I have children at different ages....is there something for each of them to do? Yes, we provide a PreK-2 Zone specifically aimed to younger children, and a Sports Zone that targets middle school aged children. All activities are engaging and interactive and fun for all ages, even adults!

Where should we park and is parking free? There are several free parking lots around the event area (Lots 1, 5, 12, 16, 18). Some require a bit more walking. Come early to get the closest spots! **Click here** for a parking map.

Is it handicap accessible? Yes – there is handicap parking available (closest lot is #18) and the event is all on one level with no stairs. **Click here** for a parking map.

Do I need to wear any special clothing? No special clothing is needed. There are both indoor and outdoor activities, so come dressed for the weather.

Is adult supervision of children provided? No, you are responsible for your own children.

Are pets allowed? No, only assistance pets are allowed.
