1) Electives are needed to reach the required minimum 122 credit hours; 2) Elective courses may be utilized to achieve a minor in a specified and university approved discipline; 3) 30 hours of coursework must be completed at BGSU; 4) 40 credit hours must be completed at the 3000/4000 level at BGSU; 5) students must complete at least two years of the same foreign language in high school or they will be required to take the equivalent at the college level; 6) In order to become a licensed Dietician students must complete a Dietetic Internship after graduation; 7) a GPA of 3.0 or above and volunteer experience is recommended to have a better chance of being accepted into a Dietetic Internship Program
