1. Use BGSU published class minimums:

| $1000-1999$ | 20 |

Any class that meets or exceed these minimums can be converted to regular.
2. Proration for classes that do not meet rule 1, the rates are set so that minimums enrollments that are further away from the full values are less than those closer to the full values. These percentages are applied to the total summer salary for the course regardless of the base salary amount.
3. If there are extenuating circumstances, a Dean may request to exceed the proration percentages in the attached chart. Approval by the Provost Office for those contracts to proceed to regular status is required. An email request and positive response will be sufficient for the college to proceed with making a contract regular.

Example of how course proration credit hour is calculated (using 1 XXX course with 8 enrolled in the example)
course credit hour * enrollment minimum percentage = proration credit hour rate of pay
Example: 3 cr hr course * $41 \%=1.23$ prorate credit hour of pay
