Courses with multiple components should use the primary component's first class meeting to determine exam date and time. (If there is a lecture section, this is generally the primary component.)

Courses <u>less</u> than 3 credit hours should adjust the length of the examtime. For example, a one credit hour class that meets for the first time on Monday at 9:30am would have their exam on Tues, Dec 9, 2025 from 8-9am.
