Who May Apply

To be considered for the Basic Introduction to Grants, you must meet both of the following requirements:

- Full-time faculty (Tenure-Track or Qualified Rank Faculty). Preference will be given to those within the first four years of their initial academic appointment.
- Not yet been awarded a federal grant as the prime PI.

Review of applications will begin on Monday, April 17th.

Selection Process

Enrollment is limited to 12 participants. The selection process will begin on April 17th and will continue until all positions are filled.

A team of reviewers will score applications based on the following criteria:

- A statement of research interests
- Past scholarly contributions to the field
- Preliminary work completed
- Ideas for external funding sources to support your scholarly activities

Applicants will be notified of selections by May 1, 2023
