 1. Served 25 years in Air force not a pilot. Joined military before college spent 6 years mobile radar. On a radar screen when planes hit towers apart of initial response to shut down air space. Went to school at night got a scholarship to Auburn. Gat a degree for finance and Troy for MEA 25 years in Airforce.
 2. Job at UNLB for 2 years then came to BGSU

 - i. Question 1: Where does his jurisdiction fall with scholarships. Cecilia is the VP os student enrollment management. She looks over scholarships. He gives her a top line number and she allocates the money.

- ii. Question 2: Where does that money come from? Revenue comes in from tuition, fees, and auxiliary funding. Then he allocates. Most of it comes from tuition. Push it back into future students.
- iii. Question 3: new tech building, what is financial status? It is ongoing and on track, scheduled in the spring to open a building. The building has a lot of good tech. Make sure it is all good before it's ready. Pre-open in the spring for students to see.
- iv. Question 4: Do we have a version of the tech building before this one? Yes, we had a previous building, and it was not up to date. Strategic plan is FORWARD and capital master plan includes academic building and residential halls.

Student experience is anyone who is a part of the experience. Clean up to date spaces. In the classroom, it matters a lot. Refreshing some classrooms from a tech standpoint. Subcommittees investigate student experience to decide what is important. Part of tuition revenue goes back into classroom updates. General fees go into the community for the wellbeing of all students.
- vii. Question 7: Back to strategic plan, what does the budget look like if something comes up from lobbying from students? What money is set aside for this? Smaller decisions take more time to plan out. His job is to enable your vision. If you voice concerns, he will go to his facilities team and plan to realize the concept and put a price tag against it. Time, purpose, and amount.
