 - Could be 5000 this year
 - Duo is going to be mandatory this year
 - Already used for canvas
 - Don't click on links if you don't know where they are from
 - Huge problem we are dealing with in this institution
 - 2 recent issues- meltdown and spectrum
 - 2 weaknesses in intel chips
 - Apple phones will correct an issue in phones in the next 10 days
 - System has to be changed for J term—mainly within the academic calendar
 - Working on tuition guarantee—for freshman next fall and every class after
 - Allows institution to set tuition rates for all four years without changing
 - Everyone participates
 - This includes many system changes
 - We will have a new worknet or career planning service after this summer
 - Can be used up to 5 years after graduation
 - Working on a 4-year course planning tool
 - Mobile apps for students- working on student mobile contacts becoming available
